EMAIL



- Email is used for all 2-way communication between the school and families.
- Use email to ask your teacher about anything from academic concerns to lost jumpers!
- Expect a response within 2 business days.



- Do not use email if you require an immediate response from your teacher. Call the office who can communicate your important message to your classroom teacher.



SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

The school newsletter through ePublisher is the place for big-picture communications, upcoming events, and celebrations.

Ensure you access the newsletter to be in-the-loop ahead of time!



CLASS DOJO



- DoJo is used for quick reminders about events, last minute changes to plans (eg due to weather) and reminders about things your child might need for their day.



- 2-way messaging is switched off and Dojo is not used for 2-way conversation. Parents should not send any questions or comments through Dojo.
- Not used for photographs of students or classwork.



QKR

Is used to order tuckshop, purchase school uniforms and pay for P&C events and fundraising.



FACEBOOK

Facebook is a place for celebrating school successes.

Facebook is used alongside Dojo for urgent reminders.



Q-PARENTS

QParents is the essential platform for completing consent forms and payments, as well as viewing your child's report card.

Initial set up requires 100 points of ID to ensure account security.



Q-SCHOOLS

Q-Schools provides a single access point for school apps and information. It includes access to the school Facebook page for families who do not have their own Facebook account.



SEESAW AND ONENOTE

These tools are for learning.

Seesaw and OneNote are used for classwork and learning. Families can logon to these applications to see a selection of student work made available.

Seesaw is used by our Prep - Year 3 students
OneNote is used by our Year 4 - 6 students.
